### **COLLABORATION WITH OTHER FACULTY**

#### **Marine Extension Project (MEP)**

In 1998 I was appointed as the state extension specialist in wetland and coastal resources for the LSU AgCenter and the Louisiana Sea Grant College Program. In the past two decades I have collaborated with faculty and staff on dozens of conferences and educational programs, 200+ extension and research publications, and 300+ presentations pertaining to coastal resource management, policy, and marine economics.

In July 2011, I was appointed Director of the Marine Extension Program (MEP) for the Louisiana Sea Grant College Program. In this capacity, I administer an annual operations budget of approximately \$400,000, coordinate quarterly meetings and communications, and provide administrative support for 16 subject matter specialists and coastal agents of the MEP.

#### **Center for Natural Resource Economics & Policy (CNREP)**

In 2002, I became the founding director of the LSU Center for Natural Resource Economics and Policy (CNREP). The center fosters the interaction of socioeconomic professionals to address natural resource and environmental challenges in Louisiana in the broader Gulf of Mexico region. CNREP currently has 30 active members and affiliates at universities and resource management agencies throughout the U.S. In the past 20 years, CNREP faculty located on the LSU campus have partnered with 50 public and private institutions in support of more than 100 individual research projects. My research focuses primarily on applications of economic valuation, project feasibility and cost-benefit analysis in coastal resource management and restoration.

As CNREP director, I coordinated and chaired triennial research forums in 2004, 2007, 2010, 2013, 2016 and 2019. These national conferences have become a primary venue for the presentation of economic research in coastal regions of the United States and abroad. The 2019 program featured 162 technical presentations from attendees representing 65 public and private institutions located in 22 U.S. states and five countries. To date, more than 40 public and private entities have provided direct and in-kind sponsorships for CNREP forums.
